



Frequently Asked Questions

Diesel Cook Top X100

Question 1 – Is the performance of the Cook Top the same as my domestic electric stove?

The Cook Top has a similar performance to a domestic electric ceramic cook top.

Question 2 – How many hot plates are there to cook with?

There are two areas to cook on – one being the main cooking function that is directly above the burner and a second used to simmer.

Question 3 – Does the Cook Top use the same fuel as my diesel vehicle?

Yes, the diesel for the Cook Top can be drawn from the vehicle's main fuel tank by the means of a standpipe or T piece. An optional Webasto diesel tank fitted to the draw bar is used for caravans or campers.

Question 4 – Can I integrate my Cook Top with the hot water service and air heater?

NO, the Cook Top is an independent system that only cooks and does not supply hot air or water to the vehicle

Question 5 – Is the Cook Top also an oven?

No, the Cook Top is only a 2 plate stove top

Question 6 – Will any gas or fumes get into the galley area?

As per our other diesel products, as long as the installation guidelines are followed, exhaust fumes will not enter the vehicle. The burner is also covered by the ceramic plate and there is no naked flame.

Question 7 – Are there different heat settings for the Cook Top?

Yes, there are six (6) heat settings and the maximum cooking power is 1.8kW

Question 8 – How much fuel does the Cook Top use?

0.09 – 0.19L per hour

Question 9 – Can I make toast with the Cook Top?

Yes, there are products on the market that allow you to place a steel “bracket” on the Cook Top to allow you to make toast.

Question 10 – How long does it take to boil water?

**The Cook Top takes about 3 minutes to reach optimum temperature.
Providing quality heavy based cookware is used the performance is similar to a domestic electric ceramic cook top.**

Question 11 – How long does the plate take to shut down?

It takes approximately 5 minutes for the Cook Top to shut down.

Question 12 – Is the Cook Top covered by warranty?

All Webasto products come with a 2 year warranty.

Question 13 – Can I install the Cook Top into my vehicle myself?

Yes, the installation manual is comprehensive and trained Webasto personnel are on hand to support DIY installations by phone or email.

Question 14 – What parts are provided with the unit when I purchase it?

Everything is supplied to install the cooker into a motorhome. An optional fuel tank is required for a caravan or camper, which can be supplied by Webasto.

Question 15 – What are the dimensions of the unit and does it come in different sizes?

**Width = 470mm, Depth = 320mm
Only one size is available.**

Question 16 – I have a petrol run vehicle, can I still install a diesel Cook Top?

Yes, a separate fuel tank can be fitted to the vehicle.

Question 17 – Can the Cook Top be installed externally?

Yes, attention should be paid to the routing of the exhaust in this situation.

Question 19 – What type of control does the Cook Top have?

A simple to use rotary control heat setting, ON/OFF button and high altitude button that would not normally be used in Australia.

Question 20 – What electrical connections are required?

A positive and negative wire to a reliable 12V power source.

Question 21 – Do I need to service or provide maintenance to the unit?

Question 22 – If I also have a diesel heater onboard, can I connect both units to the same fuel supply?

Yes

Question 23 – Can the Cook Top be run on BioDiesel?

No, it is not recommended to operate any Webasto product on BioDiesel.
